

Aubrey E. Galyon Award

Application Deadline: Monday, March 5, 2018

The Aubrey Galyon Award is given annually to an ISU student completing a bachelor's or master's degree in the year of application and commencing work at an accredited institution toward a Ph.D. in literature, linguistics, or rhetoric. This award (\$1000) will go to a student whose academic record demonstrates the excellence necessary for doctoral study; strong preference will be given to students showing potential for original theoretical work in their chosen fields. When other factors seem equal, the financial need of applicants will be considered.

To apply, complete this form and attach an essay (300–500 words) explaining why you intend to pursue doctoral studies in literature, linguistics, or rhetoric. If applicable, also include a brief statement (150–200 words) of financial need. The recipient of the award will be chosen by a committee of faculty members representing the linguistics program and the departments of English and WLC (World Languages & Cultures).

Completed undergraduate applications (including this page and a form cover sheet) should be returned to an English undergraduate adviser, or taken to 203 Ross. Graduate submissions should be submitted to 203 Ross Hall.
